INFECTIOUS CANINE DISEASES

Our canine companions could be exposed to serious, potentially deadly diseases every day. Here are just some of the diseases that vaccinations can provide protection against.

Contagious Cough

Often known as 'kennel cough', actually as little as 20% cases are thought to come from kennels.¹

Most dogs catch through daily adventures, such as the park, shops, shared water bowls...

The bacteria that causes it can survive in water for 6 months.²



Parvovirus

A common virus which is **usually fatal** without intensive hospital treatment.



Survival rates in untreated dogs are as low as 9%³ and 1 gram of infected faeces can **infect over 10 million** susceptible dogs.⁴

Leptospirosis

Caught from direct or indirect contact

with dog or rodent urine from water or soil.

Can be **rapidly fatal** in dogs & humans.

Cat Flu
