INFECTIOUS RABBIT DISEASES

Our rabbit companions could be exposed to serious, potentially deadly diseases every day. Here are the two most common diseases that vaccinations can provide protection against.

Myxomatosis

Myxomatosis is a widespread, life-threatening virus.

It is spread by biting insects (e.g. mosquitos and fleas) and between rabbits.

One of the top 8 causes of death in UK pet rabbits.¹



Rabbit Haemorrhagic Disease (RHD)

Frequently seen in both pet and wild rabbits in the UK.

It is spread quickly through direct or indirect contact with infected rabbits.

Some rabbits die before any signs are seen.
